ARTICLE 1

AVAILABLE PLACES FOR APPLICATION

Notice is hereby given of the application process for the Postgraduate Summer School “*Comparative Law in the Age of Globalization: Contributions from the Global South to the Contemporary Debate on Legal Theory*”, organized by the Department of Political Sciences “Jean Monnet” of the Università degli Studi della Campania *Luigi Vanvitelli*.

The number of available places is 5 (five) places reserved for foreign Ph.D. students.

ARTICLE 2

GOALS OF THE SUMMER SCHOOL

The course is addressed to foreign Ph.D. students, and offers new methodological instruments to conduct comparative law research in law and political studies with relation to globalization and cultural and political diversity. Diversity and multiculturalism have become today essential aspects of many polities and national states (unitary or federal) all around the world, making “East-West” (as well as “North-South”) comparisons vital to understand the present problems of democracy and the future of public and private law. The course will analyse the institutional and legal experience of Europe and Asia through the participation of scholars from both sides and the organization of joint seminars.

Applications are open to foreign Ph.D. students.

ARTICLE 4

APPLICATIONS AND DEADLINE

The **application form** for the Summer School will be submitted to the Department of Political Sciences “Jean Monnet”, viale Ellittico n. 31, 81100, Caserta, **starting from the day that follows the publication of this notice up until 12:00 a.m. of the 25th of July 2018**. The application, along with the attachments, may be submitted by ordinary mail employing registered mail with return receipt, or by certified email. The envelope or the subject of the email must clearly report: *Application for Summer School 2018*.

The application form must contain the full name, permanent address, phone number and the email address of the candidate.

Candidates must submit the following documents, as attachments to the application form:

- 1) self-declaration affidavit including an indication of the degree attained, the date and University and the comprehensive final grade;
- 2) curriculum vitae;
- 3) non-authenticated photocopy of a valid identity document.

ARTICLE 5 ADMISSIONS

The available places are five and will be allocated according to the date and time in protocol order. The Department has the right to expand the available places in the event that applications for admission were to exceed the number of available places.

Upon the expiry of the aforementioned deadline, separate lists will be drawn up for each category. The rankings will be published by the 4th of September 2018.

ARTICLE 6 TUITION FEE

There is no tuition fee.

ARTICLE 7 RESPONSIBILITIES AND PROCEDURES

ARTICLE 8 PROGRAMME
